What to Bring to Summer Camp

Clothing:

- Boy Scout uniform
 - official shirt (and hanger)
 - official web or leather belt
 - official pants / shorts
 - official socks
 - official headgear
 - Troop neckerchief and slide
- tee-shirts (6)
(preferably 6 troop / activity shirts)
- long-sleeve shirt (1)
- belt
- shorts / pants (6 pair)
(preferably Scout or similar)
- underwear (6 pair)
- socks (6 pair)
- jacket / sweater / sweatshirt (1)
- swim trunks (1)
- poncho / rain-gear
- shoes (1 or 2 pair)
- hat or visor (1)
- boat shoes (1)
- inflation pants and long-sleeved shirt
(for Swimming MB)
- watch

Camping

- Boy Scout Handbook
- foot locker / duffle bag / pack (1)
- summer sleeping bag or blankets
- small pillow
- foam pad or small air mattress
- flashlight (1 or 2)
- extra batteries
- mosquito netting with poles
- compass
- personal first aid kit
- water bottle or canteen
- matches (requires Firem'n Chit)
- pocketknife (requires Totin' Chip)

Toiletries

- insect repellent (non-aerosol)
- sunblock
- chapstick
- toothbrush and toothpaste
- dental floss
- comb / brush
- soap
- shampoo
- deodorant
- body powder or baby powder
- prescription eyewear / supplies
- kleenex
- bath towel and washcloth
- beach towel

Miscellaneous

- medicines
- musical instrument
- spending money
- notebook and pen(cil)s
- Merit Badge pamphlets
- day pack
- bandana
- folding camp chair
- bag for dirty clothes
- clothesline
- Bible or other religious text
- camera (and film if needed)

Prohibited Items – Leave at Home

- ⊗ electronics
(phones, MP3 players, games)
- ⊗ candy, snacks, sodas, and so forth
- ⊗ sheath knives
- ⊗ lighters
- ⊗ candles / lanterns

We suggest that each item of clothing and equipment be labeled with the camper's name and Troop number. This will be helpful in returning lost items.
